Subject / Theme : Developmental Activities

Title : Basic Development – I

Language Development : Activity 1

- Introduce different Story Books and Picture Books to your child.
- Discuss the things seen in the pictures.
- Make up stories with your child.
 - Use actions as well with your words to grab the child's attention.

Language Development : Activity 2

- Narrate simple stories to your child.
- Ask simple questions from the stories.
- Ask the child to recall some characters of the story.

Language Development : Activity 3

- Use magic words in front of your child.
- Encourage the child to use magic words.
 - Eg.: Thank You, Please, Excuse Me, and Sorry.

Social Development : Activity 1

- Encourage your child to converse freely with visitors who come over to the house.
- Do not force them to communicate but try to make them independent towards taking initiatives to communicate.

Social Development : Activity 2

- Encourage your child to help you with household work.
 - Safe and easy household work.
- Eg.: Taking your child's help in laying the table for dinner.

Social Development : Activity 3

- Let us teach the child to keep his / her belongings back in their proper place after use.
- Any toy, crayon, etc. that the child uses, encourage the child to organize his belongings after use in a neat and tidy way.

Social Development : Activity 4

- Let us teach our child some table manners like using spoon, etc.

Social Development : Activity 5

- Let us teach our children to stay safe.
 - Keeping our hands off DANGER ZONES
 - Doors, Windows, Etc. are danger zones, we must stay clear of these areas and also ensure we are not keeping our hands on any door/window edges.
 - Staying Safe with Peers
 - We must teach our children to stay safe with their peers. Habits like PUSHING, SNATCHING, BITING, HITTING, Etc. are a strict NO.

Fine Motor Development : Activity 1

- Let us do some fun fine motor development activities.
 - Scribbling :
 - Give some crayons and blank sheets to your child and let the child scribble.
 - Drawing and Colouring
 - Similarly, let the child engage in some drawing and coloring activities.
 - Paper Tearing
 - Paper Crumbling
 - Dough Kneading
 - Clay Moulding / Modeling
