Subject / Theme : English Language

Title : Fun Reading

Task 1

Subject / Theme : Health and Well Being

Title : Mango Shake with Vanilla ice-cream

Ingredients

- 1 small mango (peeled and sliced),
- 2 tablespoon sugar,
- Half cup of water,
- 5-6 ice cubes,
- 1 glass milk,
- 2 scoop of vanilla ice-cream.

How to make

- Combine and mix mango, sugar, water, and ice cubes.
- Blend all ingredients together in a blender.
- Add milk and blend again.
- Pour it into a glass.
- Add ice-cream and sliced mango.
- Your mango shake with vanilla ice-cream is ready.

Ingredients

- 5 cup diced seedless watermelon,
- 2 tablespoon sugar,
- Juice of 1 lime,

How to make

- Pour it into a glass.
- Your watermelon slush is ready.

Title : Model of a Train (Play time)

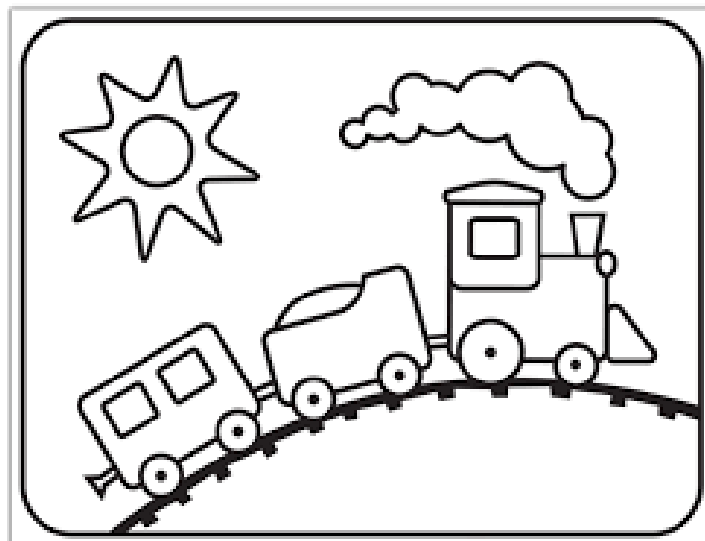
Let us make a model of a Train.

Material Required :

- Empty Match Boxes (5)
- Water Colors and Paint Brush
- Chart Paper / A4 Colored Paper
- Thread
- Scissors (Under Supervision)
- Stapler (Under Supervision)
- Adhesive (Fevicol)
- Buttons (Around 20)

Process :

- Take empty match boxes.
- Use colored sheets / charts / etc. to make 1 Engine and 4 Passenger / Cargo Cars.
- Use threads and stapler pins to join the 5 boxes.
- Now let us affix the wheels by attaching the buttons to the 5 boxes.

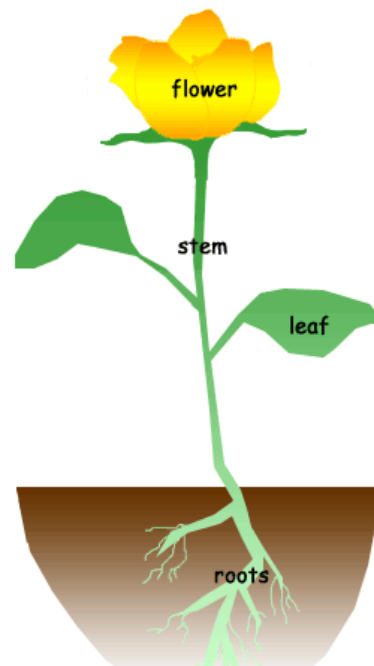
Title : Parts of a Plant - Scrap Book
