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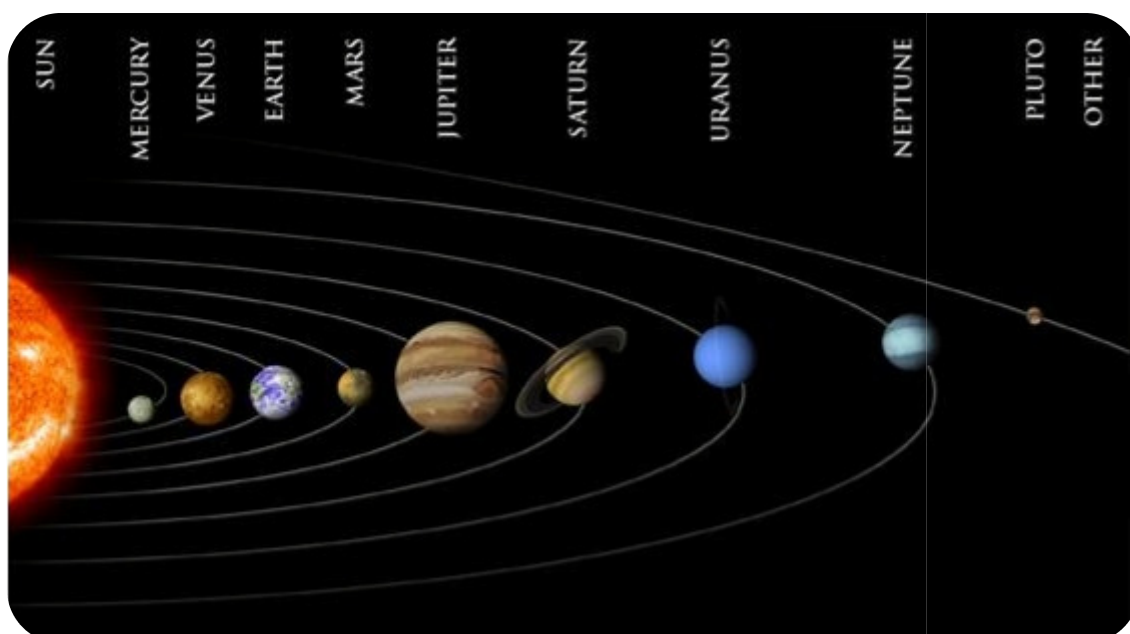

Activity

Let us make a globe:

- Material Required : A balloon (or Plastic Ball), a jar of glue, blue paint, white chart paper, paste, string , lots of paper strips from a newspaper.

- Instructions :
 - Get a round balloon. Blow it up and tie its mouth carefully.
 - Or get your plastic ball
 - Add a little water to the glue and make a solution.
 - Dip the strips of newspaper in the glue and stick them all over the balloon.
 - Wait for one day.
 - Paint the balloon with the blue paint . Let the paint dry and then label the ocean.
 - Use the chart paper to make cutouts of the continents. Write their names with black pen.
 - Stick or Tie the strings around the middle of the globe. That is Equator.
 - Apply glue on the continents and stick them on their proper place on the globe .

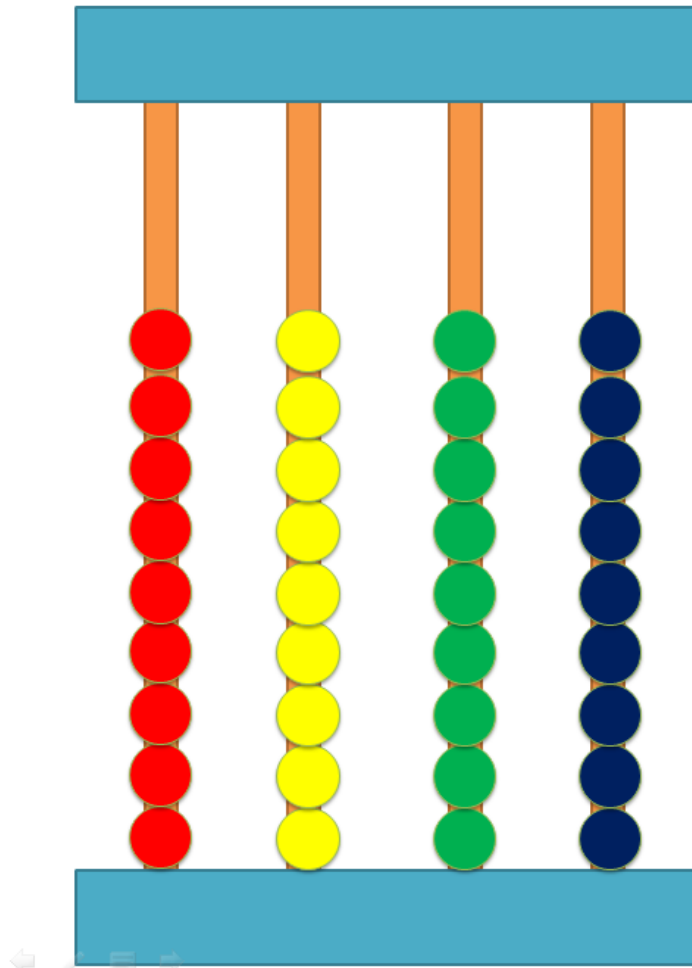
There is your globe done.

5. Take the Bottom Slab and place 4 pencils in these holes.
6. Put 9 beads in each pencil.
7. Take the Top Slab and put it on the top of these pencils.
8. Label the 4 sticks (From Right) as Ones, Tens, Hundreds, and Thousands.
9. Now we have our Abacus to count from 0 to 9999.

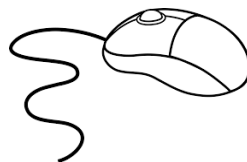
